**POSITION:** Part-Time Firefighter

## **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

East Olympia Fire District 6 is accepting applications for our Part-Time Firefighter hiring list. This position will normally work under the direction of a Lieutenant. There are times when the position will serve as company officer and/or shift leader in the absence of a Lieutenant or Captain and will then report to the shift leader or the Chief-on-Call. This position will be scheduled six 24-hour shifts and one 12-hour shift per month to a maximum of 160 hours per month.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

High school diploma or equivalent; at least 21 years of age; completion of an accredited recruit academy, in addition to having two years' experience as a volunteer firefighter; a valid Washington State Driver's License by hire date; a driving record consistent with requirements of District insurance carrier. Thurston County Medic One Protocol or obtain within 60 days of hire; Washington State EMT-B certification; and IFSAC Firefighter I certification; NWCG Certified (red card) Wildland FFII or obtain certification within one year of hire.

## **PROCESS:**

## **To submit an application:**

1. You must complete the East Olympia Fire District 6 application in its entirety. You must sign the application.
2. You must complete all the information on the background waiver. It must also **be notarized prior to application submission.**
3. **You must send a non-refundable fee of \$30 at time of application submission.**
4. You must provide a copy of your Firefighter I Certification. If you are an out-of-state applicant, you must submit a copy of your state's Firefighter I Certification.

5. If you have a Wildland Firefighter II certification you must supply a copy of it as well. If you are an out-of-state applicant you must submit a copy of your state's Firefighter II certification.
6. You must supply a copy of your Emergency Medical Technician Certification. If you are an out-of-state , you must submit a copy of your state's E.M.T. certification or National Registry.
7. Post Marks will not be accepted. The deadline for applying is **January 6, 2012** at 4:30 p.m. Completed application packets may be hand delivered to 8047 Normandy Street SE, Olympia.
