## **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

East Olympia Fire District 6 is accepting applications for a Fire Captain to fill one position. Under the direction of the Assistant Chief and the Fire Chief, this position provides direction and leadership to and for personnel of subordinate rank. The Fire Captain will assume responsibility for an administrative function of the department, currently anticipated to serve as the department training officer. This is a responder position and will serve, when assigned, as a company officer or in various command roles on emergency scenes, and serves as a command officer on call.

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. High school diploma or equivalent.
2. At least 21 years of age.
3. Three (3) years active service as a paid Lieutenant or Captain in a fire service agency.
4. Valid Washington State driver's license (by hire date).
5. Driving record consistent with requirements of District insurance carrier.
6. Obtain Thurston County Medic One Protocol within 90 days of hire.
7. Washington State EMT-B certification or National Registry.
8. EVIP Instructor certification.
9. Incident Safety Officer
10. NIMS ICS 300 Certificate.
11. Blue Card Certification (within 9 months of hire)
12. IFSAC Fire Officer 2 certification (within 1 year of hire)
13. NWCG Single Resource Boss or obtain (within 2 years of hire).

## **DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Associates Degree in Fire Science Technology, or Bachelor's Degree in a related field is acceptable.
2. NFA Managing Fire Officer
3. Washington State Certified Evaluator
4. Blue Card Instructor

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION:**

Please read carefully and follow instructions for applying for this position.

1. You must complete the East Olympia Fire District 6 application in its entirety. You must sign the application.

2. You must complete all the information on the Background waiver. It must also be notarized prior to application submission.
3. You must submit a current 5-year driving abstract with your application.
4. You must provide a copy of your Firefighter I Certification. If you are an out-of-state applicant, you must submit a copy of your state's Firefighter I Certification.
5. If you have a Firefighter II certification you must supply a copy of it as well. If you are an out-of-state applicant you must submit a copy of your state's Firefighter II certification.
6. You must supply a copy of your Emergency Medical Technician Certification. If you are an out-of-state applicant, you must submit a copy of your National Registry.
7. All documents showing that you meet the minimum qualifications for the position must be included upon submission of your application
8. Postmarks will not be accepted. The deadline for applying is **April 29, 2019** at 4:30 p.m. Completed application packets may be hand delivered to 8047 Normandy Street SE, Olympia, WA 98501, or mailed to P.O. Box 578, East Olympia, WA 98540.
