- POSITION:** Full-Time Firefighter
- DATE OPEN:** August 31, 2020
- DATE CLOSED:** September 22, 2020 (Must have taken the Public Safety Test one year prior to this closing date.)
- WAGES:** Per Local Bargaining Agreement
- ANNOUNCEMENT:** This position normally works under the supervision of a Lieutenant. There are times when the position will serve as the company officer, in the absence of a Lieutenant or Captain, and will then report to the Chief on Call. The position may be required to work an alternate “floating” schedule of 24-hour and 12-hour or 9-hour and 8-hour shifts and shall not be scheduled for more than 204 hours in a 27-day work period.

MINIMUM

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. High school diploma or equivalent.
2. At least 21 years of age.
3. Completion of a recruit academy, in addition to having two years’ experience as a volunteer firefighter, or one year as career.
4. Valid Washington State driver’s license (by hire date).
5. Driving record consistent with requirements of District insurance carrier.
6. IFSAC Firefighter I certification.
7. Hazmat Awareness & Operations Certification.
8. Washington State EMT-B certification or National Registry
9. Must Pass Thurston County Medic One Protocol within 90 days of hire.
9. NWCG Certified (red card) Wildland FFII (within 6 months).
10. Ability to drive and operate all fire and EMS vehicles of the district.

PROCESS:

Interested candidates should visit Public Safety Testing at www.publicsafetytesting.com or call 866-HIRE-911 to create an account and apply on-line for East Olympia Fire District #6.

Application Submission:

1. **Applicants that successfully complete the Public Safety Testing written exam will be notified by the District to complete an application.** You must complete the East Olympia Fire District #6 application in its entirety. You must sign the application.
2. You must complete all the information on the background waiver. It must also be notarized prior to application submission.
3. You must submit a copy of the following documents with your application:

- a. Copy of your high school diploma or equivalent
 - b. A current 5-year driving abstract.
 - c. Firefighter I Certification. If you are an out-of-state applicant, you must submit a copy of your state's Firefighter I Certification.
 - d. Wildland Firefighter II certification.
 - e. HazMat Awareness and Operations certificates.
 - f. EVIP or equivalent emergency vehicle driving certificate.
 - g. Emergency Medical Technician Certification. If you are an out-of-state applicant, you must submit a copy of your National Registry Certification.
4. Postmarks will not be accepted.
The deadline for applying is October 1, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. Completed application packets may be hand delivered to 8047 Normandy Street SE, Olympia, WA 98501.
