Under the direction of the Battalion Chief/Training, this position provides direction and leadership to and for personnel of subordinate rank. The Fire Lieutenant is also responsible for assisting in other District programs such as shift training, fire prevention, operations, EMS, suppression, staffing and other duties as assigned.
